The previous phase of this program included the terminal facility end walls and upper level entrance vestibules and exterior columns. The previous phase safetied the entrance vestibules and provided a covered walkway for passengers as well as protected working platforms. This phase will add metal panel to the exterior columns, remove stone and add metal pane to the vestibules, remove stone and add metal panel the rear of the terminal, remove and add new netting at boarding gate (12) locations as well as removing stone where necessary - all 12 gates will be revised with new safety measures.			
Explanation of Need:			
The exterior stone is a natural material and has been in service for 25 years. The natural stone exterior has grouting and other concerns. The need to expand the terminal in the near future for passenger demand has driven this project to be temporary since many of the exterior walls will be relocated when expanded. The natural stone material will be replaced with a less expensive metal panel for the temporary repair. The natural stone will likely play a role in the future expansion of the terminal. The existing Frontier ticket counter will also move to common use equipment and will require new inserts to accommodate the Amadeus ACUS equipment.
